To provide concrete ideas and tools to equip the participants to be able to teach, assess and supervise to ensure quality in courses/modules taught.
Innihald Content	 The course comprises the following main topics: A definition of university teaching & learning. Principles of good teaching. Focus on teacher cognition and teacher self-efficacy and their significance for teacher development in teaching, assessing and supervising. Diverse teaching approaches and their significance for promoting student-centered learning. Definition of assessment, principles of assessment, kinds of assessment and the role of professional ethics in teaching and assessment. Impact of feedback on student learning.
